ORDER REQUIRING ERD TO PROVIDE LIBERTY INFORMATION

¶1 The Montana Department of Labor, Employment Relations Division retains certain information concerning all workers' compensation claims in the state of Montana.

¶2 In order to identify claimants with potential *Flynn/Miller* entitlement;

¶3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Montana Department of Labor, Employment Relations Division, provide to Rex Palmer, Attorney for Petitioners, a printout from its workers' compensation database which shall include the following information:

1. Claimant's name,
2. Name of Insurer,
3. Insurer's Claim number,
4. The Social Security offset amount,
5. The date the offset was first taken,
6. The date of death, if known; and
7. The date of settlement, if the case has been settled

for all claims with a Social Security offset with a date of injury of July 1, 1974, through the present for which the following companies are or were the insurer: **Employers Insurance Company of Wausau; Hawkeye Security Insurance Company; Liberty Mutual General Insurance Company; Liberty Mutual Insurance**
