Dear Sir of Madam:

Further to Judge McCarter's request at the July 14, 2005 Common Fund Conference and my recent electronic mail exchange with Ms. Bockman of your office, I write to request the addition of my name to the service list for the above-captioned matter as respects the following affiliated companies named as defendants, for which I serve as in-house counsel:

- Swiss Reinsurance America Corporation ("SRA")
- North American Elite Insurance Company ("NAE")
- North American Specialty Insurance Company ("NAS")

In addition, Judge McCarter advised at the July 14, 2005 hearing that insurers having no claims potentially qualifying for further benefits in a common fund case may request dismissal from such case with prejudice if they provide a sworn affidavit affirming the absence of applicable claims. As indicated in my prior correspondence to this Court, while NAS wrote a limited number of workers compensation policies in Montana, it has no claims that are potentially eligible for further benefits by virtue of this common fund action.1

Accordingly, I have enclosed an affidavit executed by the NAS Senior Vice President of Claims, confirming that NAS has no claims to which this common fund action applies. In light of the foregoing and the attached affidavit, NAS respectfully requests dismissal from the abovecaptioned common fund action with prejudice. It is our understanding that this can be
