A telephone conference call came on this date at 3:30 p.m. with the above-named counsel. The conference call was scheduled at the initiation of Mr. Jones to discuss Liberty Northwest's motion to stay proceedings.

At the outset, I raised the fundamental issue of whether this Court has jurisdiction, as this matter is currently on appeal at the Montana Supreme Court. This jurisdictional issue must be decided before I can address the merits of Liberty Northwest's motion. I referred counsel to the *Michalak*¹ case in which I cited to *Murf*² and *Powder River County*.³

Mr. Jones deferred to the Court as to this Court's jurisdiction to hear its motion to stay proceedings. Ms. Wallace argued that the Court has jurisdiction over implementation issues concerning Liberty Northwest because these are ancillary issues, particularly since Liberty Northwest is not a party to the current *Schmill* appeal.

I ordered counsel to brief the limited issue of whether this Court has jurisdiction to address the merits of Liberty Northwest's motion. The parties shall file simultaneous briefs on this issue by June 12, 2009. No reply briefs will be allowed.
